**Purpose:** To set guidelines for apparatus running procedures to various types of fire calls.

The running procedures of the King of Prussia Volunteer Fire Company are posted at both Fire Stations and it is the responsibility of all Firefighters, especially Drivers, to know these procedures. (See attachment)

In the event of unusual circumstances during a fire/emergency, the Officer in Charge may, at his/her discretion, change the running procedures for that particular call only.
